JACK LEONARD MILLHOUSE (1916 – 1999)

Represented the Lincoln Diocesan Guild on the Central Council
from 1960 - 1989 and attended 28 meetings

Born at Lincoln on 17th April 1916:

Began ringing at Lincoln Cathedral in 1934 and was attached to St Giles, Lincoln from 1936.

Rang his first peal on 23rd February 1935: 5 methods Minor at Navenby, Lincs.

Rang a total of 2258 peals, conducting 1311; 1766 were rung for the Lincoln Diocesan Guild.

His notable achievements include being the first Lincolnshire man to ring 1000 (2.10.1963) and 2000 (20.12.1984) peals; ringing in the then record peals of Spliced Minor (100, 102, 104 and 125 methods); a peal of 14144 London Surprise Major (Heydour, 4.10.1947); calling the first peals of Stedman Cinques for at least 90 people.

He featured in the Ringing World article 'Personalities of the Exercise' no 11 (RW 17.3.1961).

Occupation: Upholsterer.

Died on 29th August 1999.
