WALTER ALLMAN

Representative of the Chester Diocesan Guild 1957 - 1959

Attended 3 meetings

Born at Crewe on 27th February 1910

Began ringing at Runcorn in 1935.

Rang his first peal on 11th December 1937: Plain Bob Minor at Davenham, Cheshire.

Rang a total of 346 peals for the Chester Guild; full total unknown.

Some notable achievements include silent peals of London, Bristol and 4 Spliced Surprise Major (in the 1940's); long lengths of Bristol Surprise Major (21600, 4.11.1950 at Over, Cheshire) and Cambridge Surprise Royal (15480, 15.12.1951 at Worsley, Lancs); and London Surprise Major on the back eight at Manchester Town Hall (16.4.1949).

He served the Church of All Saints Runcorn for over 50 years

Occupation: Window cleaner.

Died on 25th August 1989.
