James Kenneth Armstrong was born in Scotland in 1889.

He learned to ring in Bodenham, Herefordshire, where he rang one or two peals.

In 1922 he moved to Prestbury near Cheltenham and was attached to the tower there until ringing was stopped due to the second World War.

He did not take up ringing again after the war. He moved from Prestbury to Bristol in 1950 and then moved to Southam near Cheltenham in 1954.

His main interests then were gardening and football.

He was a school teacher by profession.

He died in 1964.
