

## ALDRINGTON, SUSSEX



At least two of these badges have survived. The silver hallmarks on the reverse of this example show it to have been made by H J Cooper & Co of Holborn Circus, London, and assayed in Birmingham in 1929. The design is broadly similar to that used by George Stacey (q.v.). The inscription of the obverse reads, 'RINGER OF S<sup>T</sup> LEONARDS ALDRINGTON SUSSEX COUNTY ASSOCIATION'
