Help Desk

Car parking

Campus Parking

Visitor parking is indicated on the map, by letters A to L. Parking is free on campus after 6pm each evening and **is free during weekends and bank holidays**. All the visitor zones have a pay and display machine should anyone arrive onto campus earlier. Guests staying on campus on Tuesday morning should check with the appropriate receptions as to car parking arrangements.

Hotel Parking

Lancaster House Hotel is situated adjacent to the university campus and can be easily accessed from Green Lane, just off the A6.

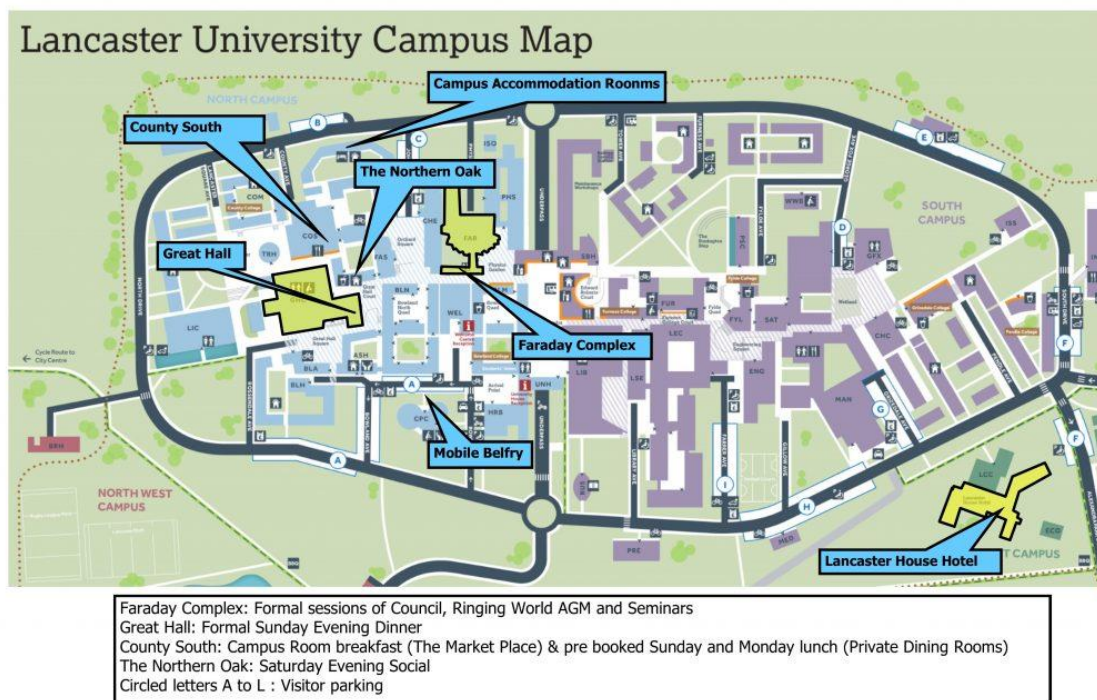

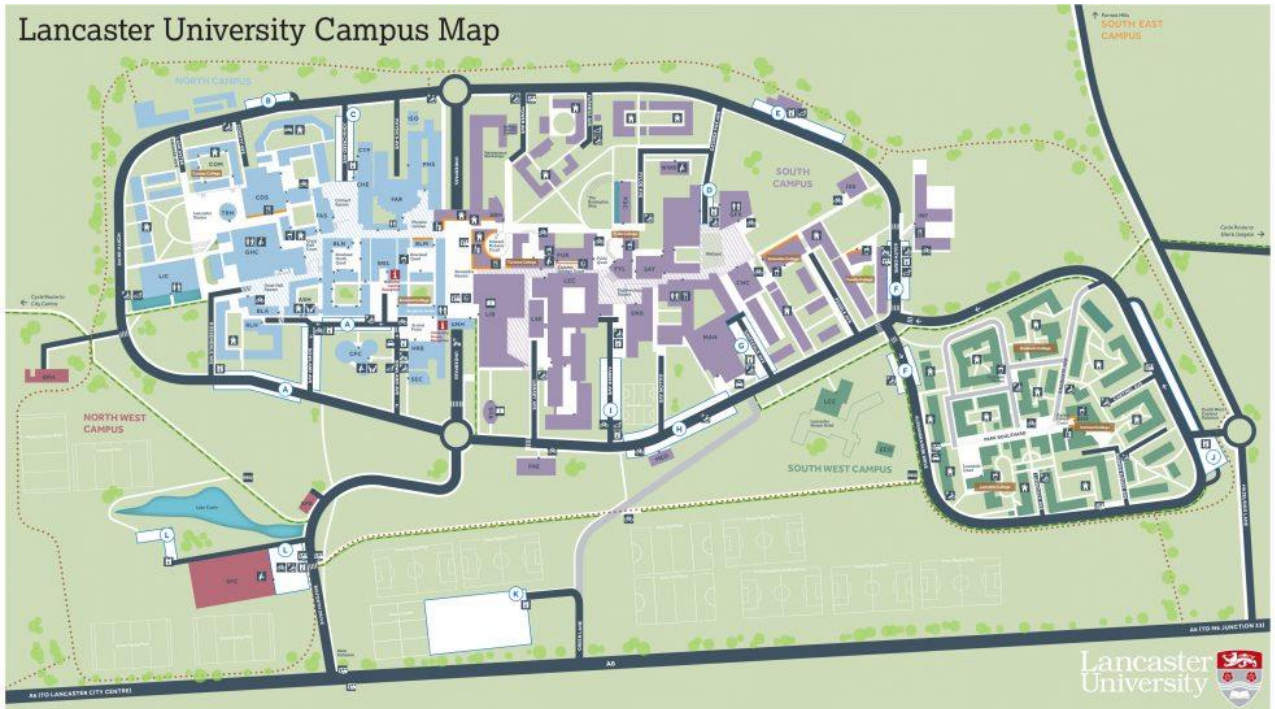
